What is PTE-Academic ?

PTE stands for the Pearson Test of English. It is also known as PTE-A, Pearson Test of English Academic. PTE Academic is a computer-based academic English language test aimed at non-native English speakers willing to study abroad. It tests Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking. The test length is 180 minutes in total. Its results are widely accepted by the Universities and Colleges throughout the globe.

Read Aloud



What is Read Aloud?

Read Aloud is the first question type of Speaking Section that a test taker will face during PTE Academic Examination. Here, the test taker needs to read the given text loudly and clearly. Before doing so, the test taker will get 30-40 seconds to look at the given paragraph. After completion of that given time, a beep will be played then the test taker shall start reading. But make sure that the recording on your computer screen is on. Marks will be distributed over Speaking and Reading.

Three things need to be considered seriously while dealing with Read Aloud.

1. Content
2. Pronunciation
3. Fluency



Repeat Sentence



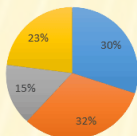
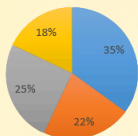
What is Repeat Sentence?

Repeat Sentences is the second question type of speaking section. Here, the test taker needs to repeat whatever he/she hears on the head-set. Usually, a sentence not more than 14 words will be played on the head-set. Unlike read aloud, there will be any beep to signal. So, the test taker needs to keep his eyes constantly on the screen in order to see the recording status. Marks will be distributed over Speaking and Listening .

Three things to remember during Repeat Sentence.

1. Content
2. Pronunciation
3. Fluency

Describe Image



What is Describe Images?

Describe Image is the third question type of speaking section. Here, an image will be provided and the test taker needs to describe that provided image for 40 seconds. Before Speaking, the test taker will get 25 seconds to look at the image. The test taker will not hear any beep sound. So, he/she needs to be very careful, and should always keep their eye on the recording status on the screen. Marks will solely be allocated to Speaking.

Three things to remember during Describe Images.

1. Content
2. Pronunciation
3. Fluency

Re-tell Lecture



What is Retell Lecture?

Re-tell Lecture is the fourth question type of Speaking Section. Here, 60-90 seconds long lecture will be played. After listening to the lecture, the test taker needs to re-tell that lecture for 35-40 seconds. Mark will be distributed over Speaking and Listening.

Three things to remember during Re-tell Lecture.

1. Content
2. Pronunciation
3. Fluency

Answer Short Question



What is Answer Short Question?

It is the fifth and final question type of Speaking Section. Here, a question will be played, and the test taker needs to answer the question in a word or maximum 3 words. Marks will be distributed over Speaking and Listening.

Three things need to be considered seriously while dealing with Answer Short Question.

- 1. Listen Carefully- Keep your ears open**
- 2. Do not Overthink**
- 3. Make your Vocabulary and Grammar stronger**

Summarize written text & Essay



Summarize written text: (10 minutes)

What is summarize written text?

A paragraph, not more than 300 words, will be given on the computer screen. The test taker needs to read that paragraph, and summarize it. The summarization needs to be done in a sentence within 5-75 words. The obtained marks will be distributed over Speaking and Writing. Time allocated is 10 minutes.

Essay: (20 minutes)

What is an essay?

Here, a topic will be given on the computer screen. The test taker needs to write an essay on that topic. The word limit for the essay is 200-300 words, and the time allocated is 20 minutes.

Reading and writing: Fill in the blanks:

What is Reading and writing: Fill in the blanks?

A paragraph will be provided with multiple blanks in it. The options will be provided on the blanks themselves, that's why it is also known as drop-down fill in the blanks. Each blank will carry 1 mark. The marks acquired will be distributed over Reading and Writing.

Multiple choice, choose multiple answer:

What is multiple choice, choose multiple answer?

A paragraph will be given on the left side of the monitor. On the right-hand side, a question with multiple options will be there. It is the question type where the test taker can choose more than one answer from the option. However, there will be negative marks too. So, the test taker should only choose multiple options only if they are confident.

Re-order Paragraphs:

What are Re-order Paragraphs?

Here, multiple paragraphs will be provided on the left side of the computer screen. The provided paragraphs will not be in the correct order. The test takers need to transfer those paragraphs into the right side, and ensure those paragraphs are in correct order. Marks will be given on the basis of the correct pairings.



Reading: Fill in the blanks:

What is reading fill in the blanks?

A paragraph will be provided with multiple blanks in it. The options will be provided at the end of the paragraph. The test takers need to look for the appropriate option and put them into their respective blanks, that's why it is also Known as drag and drop fill in the blanks. Each blank will carry 1 mark.

Multiple choice, choose single answer:

What is Multiple choice, choose single answer?

**A paragraph will be given on the left side of the monitor. On the right-hand side, a question with multiple options will be there. It is the question type where the test taker needs to choose only one answer from the options.
1 mark for one correct answer.**

LISTENING: (45-57 minutes)

- Summarize spoken text
- Multiple choice, multiple answer
- Fill in the blanks
- Highlight correct summary
- Multiple choice, choose single answer
- Select missing word
- Highlight incorrect words
- Write from Dictation

Summarize spoken text:

What is summarize spoken text?

Here, almost 60-90 seconds long lecture will be provided. After listening to the lecture, the test taker needs to summarize that lecture within 10 minutes, and in-between 50-70 words. Spellings and structures are necessary. It is almost like re-tell lecture. The only difference is the test taker needs to write the summary here in summarize spoken. The marks will be allocated to listening and writing

Multiple choice, choose multiple answer:

What is multiple choice, choose multiple answer?

Unlike the reading's "multiple choice, multiple answer", the test taker won't get the paragraphs to read. Rather, an audio clip will be played. After hearing that audio clip, the test taker can choose more than one answers from the options given on the screen. Question will also be there on the screen. However, there will be negative marking. So, be careful.

Fill in the blanks:

What is fill in the blanks?

Here, a paragraph will be displayed on the computer's screen with some blanks in-between, and that same paragraph gets played on the head-set. Now, the test taker needs to keep their eyes continuously on the screen while their ears must be open to the audio. By this way, they can fill the missing blanks accordingly. The marks will be allocated to listening and writing.



Highlight Correct Summary:

What is highlight correct summary?

Here, an audio clip will be played. Meanwhile, 3-4 options will also be provided on the computer screen. The test taker needs to choose one option (summary) over other. The marks will be distributed to listening and reading.

Multiple choice, choose single answer:

What is multiple choice, single answer?

Unlike the reading's "multiple choice, single answer", the test taker won't get the paragraphs to read. Rather, an audio clip will be played. After hearing that audio clip, the test taker shall choose only one answer from the options given on the screen. Question will also be there on the screen.

Select missing word:

What is select missing word?

Here, an audio clip will be played. And, at the end of the audio clip, a word will be replaced by a beep sound. The options will be there on the screen. The test takers need to choose the correct option.

Highlight incorrect words:

What is highlight incorrect words?

Just like listening fill in the blanks, a paragraph will be displayed on the screen, and that same paragraph gets played on our head set as well. But, instead of some blanks, there will be some words which they are going to mispronounce. The test taker needs to find those miss-pronounced words and highlight them. However, there will be negative marking. So, needs to be extra careful. The marks will be distributed over listening and reading.

Write from Dictation:

What is write from dictation?

It is the last question of the PTE. A sentence will be played on the head-set. The test taker needs to write down that sentence. The obtained marks will be dispersed over listening and writing.
