Documents for F1 Visa (Student Visa)

- Educational transcripts
- No Objection Certificate (NOC)
- A Non-immigrant Visa Electronic Application (DS-160) Form. Visit the [DS-160 web page](#) for more information about the DS-160.
- A passport valid for travel to the United States with a validity date at least six months beyond your intended period of stay in the United States
- One (1) 2"x2" (5cmx5cm) photograph taken within the last six months
- A receipt showing payment of your US\$160 non-refundable nonimmigrant visa application processing fee paid in local currency.
- Educational transcripts
- An approved Form I-20 from your U.S. school or program
- All prospective F and M students are required to pay the I-901 Student and Exchange Visitor Information System ([SEVIS](#)) Fee before scheduling the appointment
- Interview appointment letter confirming that you booked an appointment through [this service](#).

How to Apply

- Complete the [Nonimmigrant Visa Electronic Application \(DS-160\) form](#). That will be provided from the [Consular Electronic Application Center](#). You have to complete several login processes. After filling all the requirements note that 10 Digits bar code. It is needed for further processes.
- Pay the visa application fee click [here](#). You can pay your fees from NIBL on Cash or from Online also. For more information on how to pay your fees click [here](#).
- Schedule your appointment on [this](#) web page. You will need the following information in order to schedule your appointment:
 - 1) Your passport numbers
 - 2) The receipt number from your Visa Fee receipt. (Click [here](#) if you need help finding this number.)

- 3) The ten (10) digit barcode number from your DS-160 confirmation page
- Visit the **U.S. Embassy or Consulate** on the date and time of your visa interview. You must bring a printed copy of your appointment letter, your DS-160 confirmation page, one photograph taken within the last six months, your current and all old passports, and the original visa fee payment receipt. Applications without all of these items will not be accepted.

For Visa Interview, students need to collect the mention documents:

- a) A Complete Academics Certificate
- b) Appointment Letter or F1 visa or Students Visa interview schedule
- c) DS 160 confirmation page, Non Immigrant Visa Application Form
- d) A Valid Passport
- e) A Recent Photo 2inch X 2 inch, white background, without any make up and specs, and should be in a soft copy not exceeding 25 mb
- f) Application Fee payment Receipt
- g) Proficiency test certificate (IELTS or TOEFL)
- h) Offer Letter from the Universities and Colleges from USA.
- i) Scholarship Test Certificate (SAT, GRE or GMAT)
- j) I20 or offer letter from accepted US universities
- k) Bank Statement and Certificate from A grade bank only. (Minimum 3 months if not 2-3 days old), Certificate and Affidavit of Support Form. Bank Balance Amount: (450000-50000 Lakhs). Depending upon updated exchange rate of Country Currency (USA, UK & Canada)

After the Student is granted for F1 Visa or student visa by the Embassy they are required to collect the documents such as

- 1) Police Clearance Certificate Report (A passport or citizenship and a recent photo of the students).
- 2) Medical Report (A form, a recent photo or government id (a passport or citizenship) i20 or offer letter . Students need to test and collect the medical documents from I.O.M test center.
